Consumer Price Index – February 2013


Information released today by Statistics Canada indicates that the Yellowknife All-Items Consumer Price Index rose 1.9% from February 2012. By comparison, the annual price change was 1.2% for Canada, 1.8% for Whitehorse and 0.9% for Edmonton.

Compared to February 2012, consumer prices in Yellowknife increased for all major components. Contributing to the overall increase was a 3.9% increase in clothing & footwear, a 3.7% increase in alcoholic beverages & tobacco products, and a 2.8% increase in transportation. While clothing & footwear prices are higher than 12 months ago, they are below the seasonal peak experienced last November, having fallen in each of the last three months.

Comparing January to February 2013, overall prices in Yellowknife increased by 0.2%. Most major components experienced a price increase from last month; the two exceptions were price decreases for household operations & furnishings and clothing & footwear.

CPI values for Yellowknife and Whitehorse include estimates of price changes for owned

accommodation based on the price of rental accommodation. As a result, the all-items indexes published for these centers are not strictly comparable to those for Canada and Edmonton.
