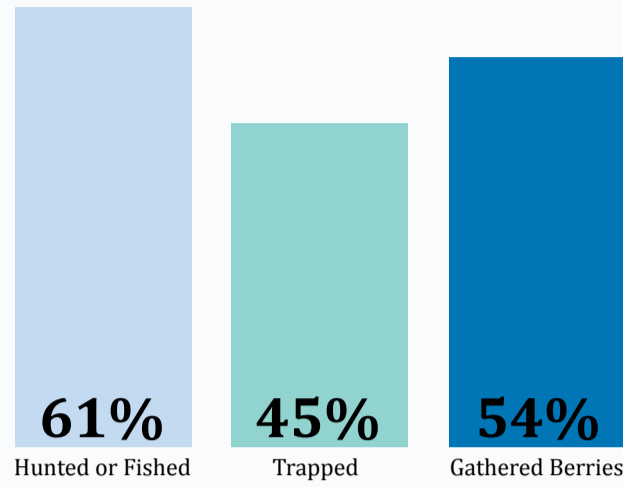

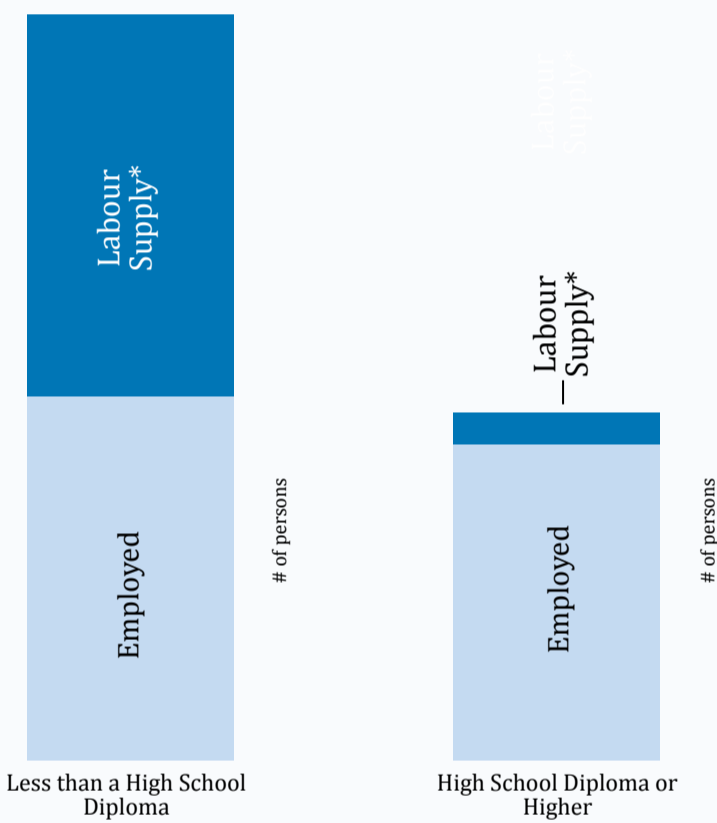

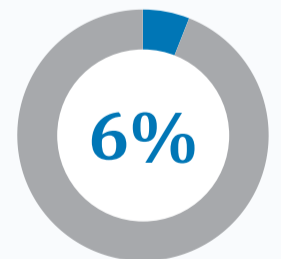
of dwellings do not have enough bedrooms
