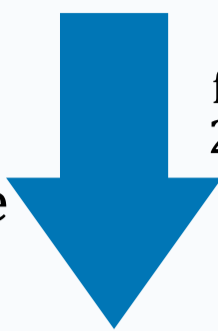

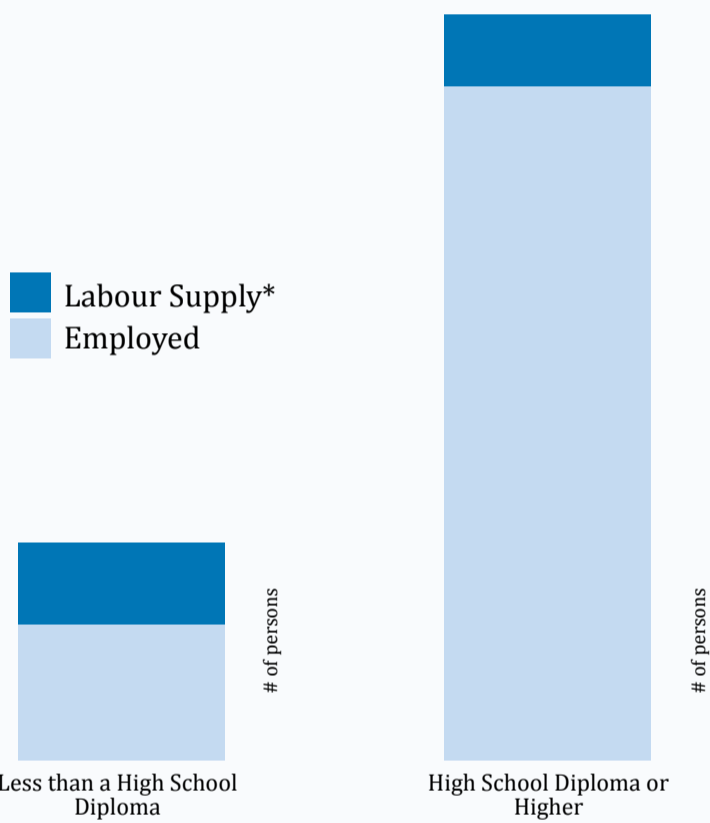

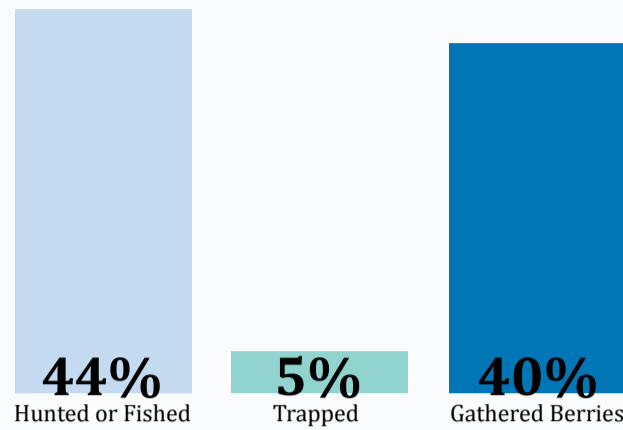
Employment and Education

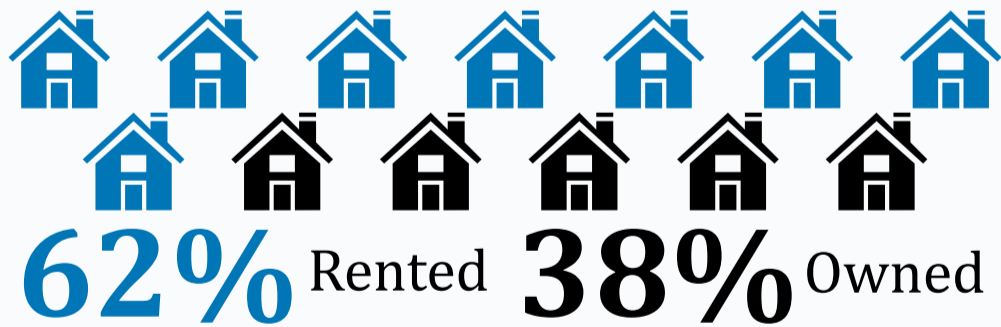

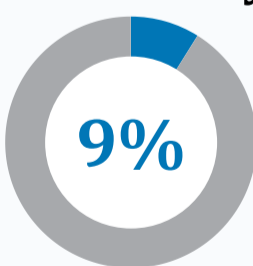

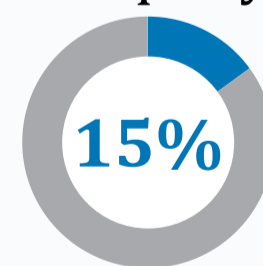

Suitability



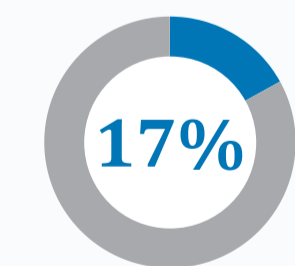
of dwellings do not have enough bedrooms
