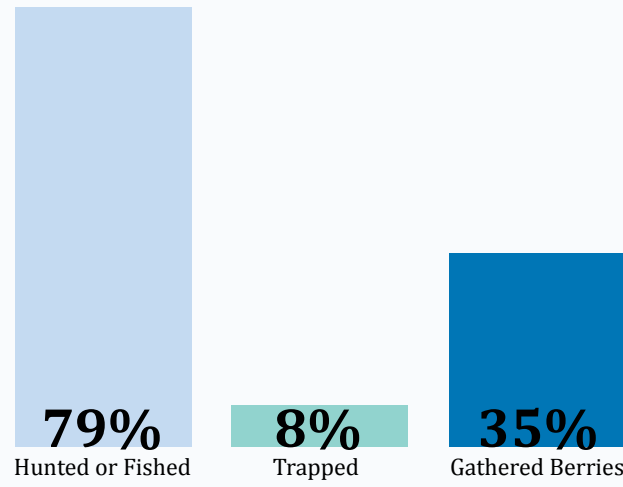

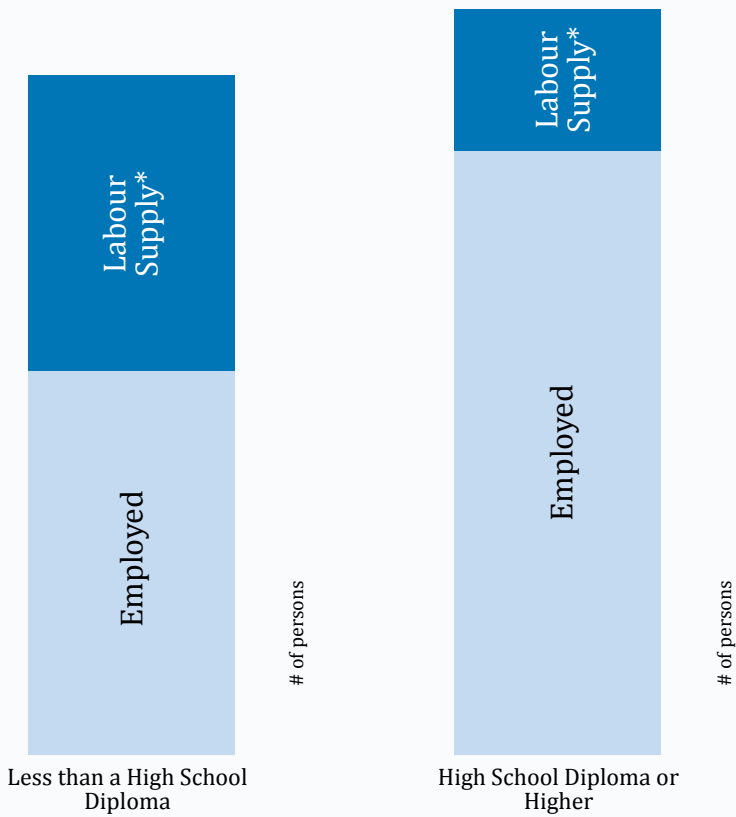

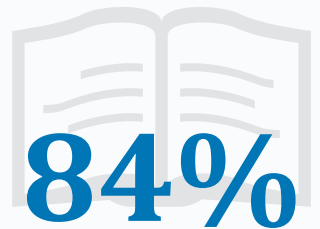
Labour Force

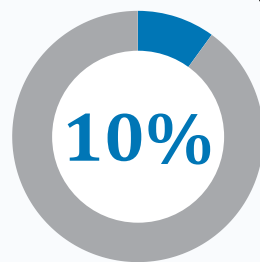

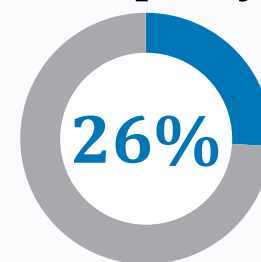

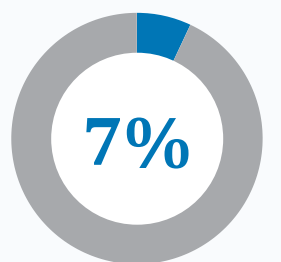
