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
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Northwest Territories Population April 2024

On April 1, 2024 Statistics Canada estimated that 44,920 people were living in the Northwest Territories. Between April 1, 2023 and April 1, 2024, the population in the Northwest Territories increased by 242 persons. The components of natural increase during this one-year period consisted of 507 births and 331 deaths, resulting in a net increase of 176 persons. There was a net loss of 625 interprovincial migrants and a net gain of 691 international migrants.

In the NWT, population growth fluctuates based on migration patterns; generally, net interprovincial migration has been mostly negative, offset by positive net international migration and natural increase. NWT's net international migration has been on an increase since late 2020. In the second quarter of 2024 it reached its highest level since the availability of comparable data (third quarter of 1971) (Figure 1).

At the national level, between April 1, 2023 and April 1, 2024, Canada's population increased by 3.2%. Alberta experienced the largest population increase followed by Ontario and British Columbia, all exceeding Canada's growth.
