Northwest Territories Population April 2025

On April 1, 2025 Statistics Canada estimated that 45,242 people were living in the Northwest Territories. Between April 1, 2024 and April 1, 2025, the population in the Northwest Territories increased by 556 persons (+1.2%). The components of natural increase during this one-year period consisted of 483 births and 334 deaths, resulting in a net increase of 149 persons. There was a net loss of 137 interprovincial migrants and a net gain of 544 international migrants.




Figure 1 Migration Patterns and Population Growth, Northwest Territories, October 1, 2020 to April 1, 2025

In the NWT, population growth fluctuates based on migration patterns; generally, net interprovincial migration has been mostly negative, offset by positive net international migration and natural increase. NWT's net international migration had been on an increase since late 2020. However, after reaching its highest level in the second quarter of 2024, it has been on a downward trend (Figure 1).

Government of Northwest Territories Nationally, Canada's population increased by 1.2% between April 1, 2024 and April 1, 2025. Among jurisdictions, Alberta experienced the largest population increase (+2.9%), followed by Nunavut (+1.8%) and Saskatchewan (+1.7%). Quebec and Northwest Territories mirrored the national growth, while British Columbia, Ontario, Nova Scotia and Newfoundland and Labrador had growth rates below the national level.
