

## **Northwest Territories Population** January 2021

On January 1, 2021 Statistics Canada estimated that 45,136 people were living in the Northwest Territories, a gain of 17 persons from a year previously. Between January 1, 2020 and January 1, 2021, the components of natural increase consisted of 572 births and 264 deaths, resulting in a net increase of 308 persons. Interprovincial migration accounted for 1,674 persons moving into the Northwest Territories from other provinces and territories, while 2,015 persons moved away, representing a net loss of 341 persons. Internationally, there was a net in-migration of 50 persons.

Interprovincial migration is the main driver of population change in the Northwest Territories. Historically, migration generally follows a seasonal pattern with more people moving to and from the territory in the first half of the year compared to the latter half (Figure 1).

At the national level, Canada's population growth in 2020 was 1.1 percentage points lower than in 2019 primarily due to decreased international migration and increased number of deaths due to COVID-19 pandemic. Smaller growth rates compared to the previous year were prevalent throughout all the provinces and territories except for Nunavut which grew by 1.8% (Table 1). Growth was negative in Newfoundland and Labrador (-0.6%).
