
Consumer Price Index – April 2019 -

Information released today by Statistics Canada indicates that the Yellowknife All-Items Consumer Price Index in April rose by 1.8% compared to one year ago. By comparison, the annual price increase was 2.0% for Canada, 2.1% for Edmonton, 1.4% for Whitehorse and 1.9% for Iqaluit.

ALL-ITEMS CONSUMER PRICE INDEX (2002=100)

Between April 2018 and April 2019, Yellowknife consumer prices increased for all major components with transportation and shelter experiencing the largest increases, rising by 3.0% and 2.3% respectively.



After reaching a peak in September 2018, energy prices declined until January 2019, but have increased in every subsequent month. Between April 2018 and April 2019 energy prices increased by 2.8%, a result of higher prices for gasoline (+4.4%), fuel oil and other fuels (+2.4%) and electricity (+1.4%).
