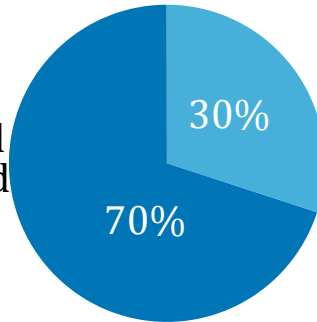

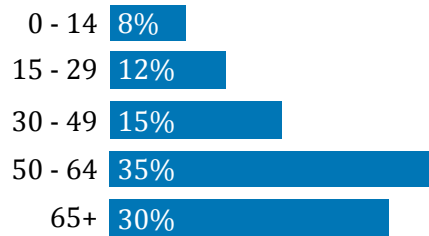

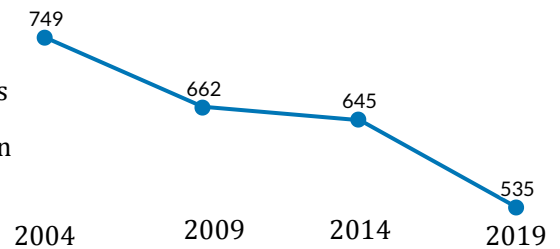

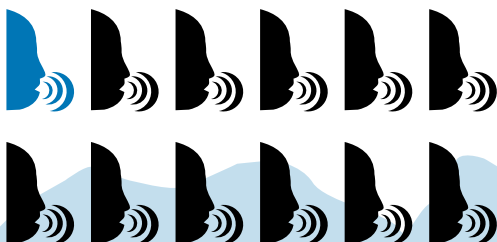

Of these, approximately 1 in 3 already understand at least some of the language

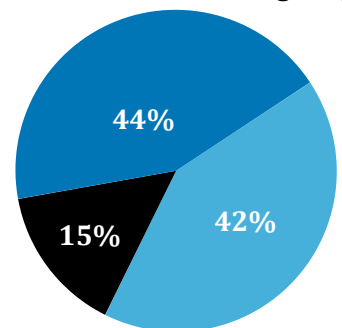
