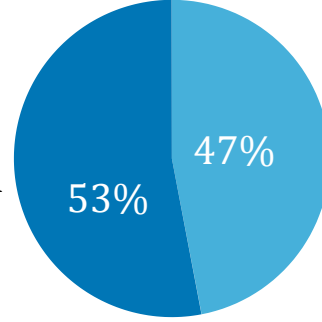

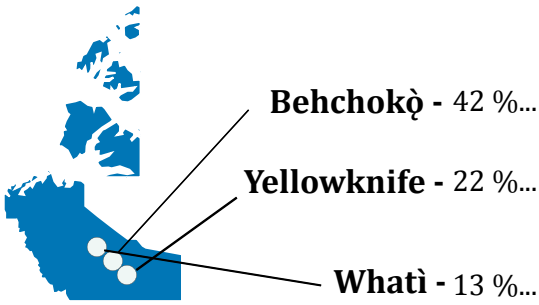

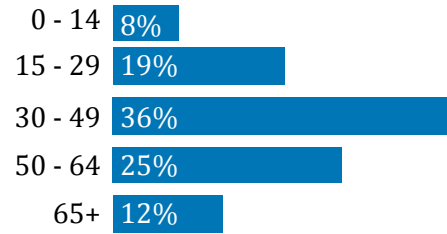

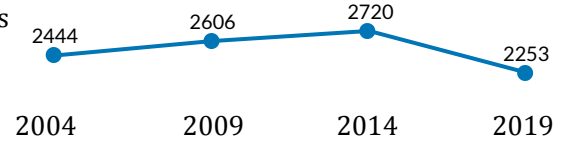

half already understand at least some of the language



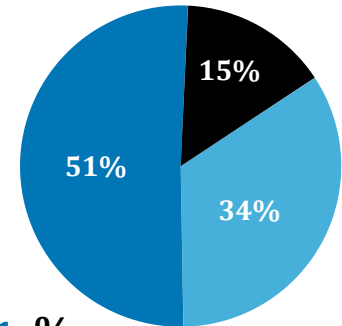
